Grants so welcomed

STUDENTS and staff at the Kings College (formerly El Shaddai College) in Wellard are set to benefit from three Australian Government grants totalling \$129,400 under the Federal Government's Investing in Our School program.

On hand to do the honours for the Government was Senator Mathias Corman, who said the grants would be used to fit out the home economics classroom, the science and computer laboratories and provide carpets, playground equipment, a projector and screen and air-conditioning and library software.

Senator Corman said the projects would provide the necessary school upgrades giving the students up-to-date learning facilities to enhance their education and well-being.

A school spokeswoman said the grants made last Friday morning were followed by a morning tea and an open day at the college.

"Many changes have been made at the college and we were excited to be able to show off our new facilities," she said.
