Senate orders 'Operation Sunlight' for Super Info

The Gillard government has been ordered by the Senate to release important information about the Henry Tax Review's recommendations on superannuation.

The Henry Review made a series of specific recommendations on our superannuation system.

The government ignored these and instead pursued an agenda which the Review rejected.

There has been much talk from the government about new paradigms and a supposed commitment to more openness and transparency.

Yet so far the Gillard government has refused to release any of the Treasury modelling or any other relevant advice it has received about the Henry Tax Review recommendations on superannuation.

The public has been completely left in the dark about why the government rejected the Henry Tax Review's assessment that increasing the superannuation guarantee levy would hurt low income working families.

The Senate today ordered the government to finally release all that information by tomorrow.

Release of that information is in the public interest to enable a fully informed community discussion about the best way forward for superannuation.
